simply did a back flip and never moved.

"Examination showed tremendous internal damage and no exit. wound. He reacted to hydro-static shock just as any animal or man will react - like it's almost certain curtains for the nervous system, along with playing hell with one's anatomy.

"The second shot was out around 130 yards, and this time it was my bullet that touched home-base somewhere in the vicinity of the critter's solar plexus; the result was not too surprising for a high-velocity projectile - the animal literally exploded.

"I do not know whether it was one of those good shooting days for Jerry and myself, or a combination of this and reasonably close ranges, but we killed seven chucks that had been a problem to a local dairy farmer. We had aimed at seven. Not one ever made it back to the hole; most were feet-up upon bullet contact and stone dead by the time the echo of the shot disappeared among the hills.

"There is little more I can say about the .17s or about the total Winslow product. I doubt that it will in any way replace the center fire 22s in popularity among varmint shooters, but I do know that it is capable of doing things that many shooters might doubt. Especially if they never had the opportunity to see it perform."

We checked to see about the business of mounts for the finished Winslow rifle and found it uses the #SR-ST-SA Redfield, or the bases #66 and 67 from Weaver.

The new custom Winslows will be available from the Winslow Arms Company, Venice, Florida. Prices start at \$405, but more intricate stock work by Hultgren raises the price to various higher priced grades.

"Needless to say, I'll never use the 17/223 on anything larger than varmints, but some clinical observation tells me that such a vicious little bitch is all too capable of doing frightful, final things to much larger thin-skinned animals. What light, fast bullets can do to an adversary at combat ranges long has been the subject of controversy among the military - although admittedly not in the .17 calibers.

"But I can most certainly imagine that this pinhole, high-performance rifle, in any of the offered .17 calibers, will find favor with those dedicated shooters who soon will come to realize its particuar effectiveness." •
